


ECONOMIC DASHBOARD

The Economic Dashboard signals how various areas of the economy are performing. Consumer spend is up to March 2021, House Prices are from April 2021, Visitor Spend is from Year Ending March 2021.





SECTOR DASHBOARD

We've identified some sectors that are important points of difference for the identity and economy of Whanganui. We work closely with these sectors and see their success as critical to our larger plan for economic development. The Sector Dashboard is updated annually and currently reflects data from the year ending March 2020 compared to data from the year ending March 2019.

The Annual Economic Dashboard reflects the performance of our economy, particularly how it impacts our lifestyle and people. Figures are from YE March 2020, except for unemployment rate, labour force participation rate and NEET rate, which are from YE Dec 2020.
